

It is important to develop the skill of coping up with the stress they get during teenage period. The session was started by the statement "Coping with the teenage stress" that holds very true in today's scenario where everyone is in constant bafflement and riddles, where every moment is a testing moment and where running hands of the clock reminds us that we have to run & bear the loads of responsibilities and live up the expectations of everyone around. All these situations create and lead to stress & strain in life. In order to help the students to learn to cope up with the stress which they face in classrooms or at personal places, one and a half hour session was handled by Mrs. N. Prabha, Assistant Professor of Education. 50 students from Prasanna Matriculation Higher Secondary School, Puthiamputhur have participated.

The main highlights of the session were the signs of stress recognized by the teenagers, causes of stress, stress relaxation therapy that could be followed & the different stress management techniques. Also she explained that Stress can be good or bad and it's our attitude how we handle and tackle with it. Then some students revealed their real situations which lead them to get stress. Then the resource person mentioned that it is very important to vent out the feelings to the person who could provide the best instead of keeping the knots in the mind. At the end, the students were divided into 4 groups and they had some fun activities with regard to the stress buster. The session got concluded with a big smile on the faces of students & with a promise to deal with stress in a positive way.

The programme gets started with a prayer song. Mrs. N. Prabha gave a welcome note and a short introduction about the guest speaker Mrs. A. Rajeswari, Principal, Prasanna Matriculation Higher Secondary School, Puthiamputhur. At the initial part, the resource person talked the adolescent students and how they differ from young students. She revealed that the adolescents can be challenging cohort to teach and they often rebel against the rules & authority figures. At the same time, adolescents are filled with energy, creativity and self expression and she emphasized that it is the teacher's responsibility to find some positive ways to channelize their energy in the constructive path. She said that the teachers must learn to manage the more resistant aspects of their student's personalities. Resource person gave some effective classroom management strategies which the student teachers can use it while they go for real teaching. Some suggestions given by her to manage the adolescent classroom are as follows,

- · Clearly state the rules and expectations
- · Get to know your students
- · Building rapport with your students.
- Treat your students with respect.
- Encourage creativity & self expression
- Changing the environment
- Establish a reward system for good behavior & academic achievement.





### Report on Faculty Exchange Program

In accordance with the Memorandum of Understanding between Annammal College of Education for Women, Thoothukudi and St. Ignatius College of Education, Palyamkottai, Faculty Exchange Program was organized from 19-04-2021 to 22-04-2021. The Faculty Exchange Program was done online considering the pandemic situation in the country. A series of four lectures were arranged on these days. Two of these lectures were for the students of Annammal College of Education by the faculty members of St. Ignatius College of Education. The other two lectures were for the students of St. Ignatius College of Education by the faculty of Annammal College of Education for Women.

- Dr. N. TheresitaShanthi, Controller of Examinations and Assistant Professor of Physical Science, St. Ignatius College of Education gave a special lecture on "Socialization in the Digital Era". She began with defining socialization and introduced the different agents of socialization. She then elaborated on how socialization has changed with the advent of digital era. She gave a detailed account of the positive and negative impacts of digital socialization. The lecture was followed by interaction and the students clarified their doubts and gave their feedback on the lecture. The session ended with the vote of thanks proposed by Dr. R. Suryakala, Assistant Professor of Education, Annammal College of Education for Women.
- Dr. R. Indra Mary Ezhilselvi, IQAC Coordinator and Assistant Professor of Psychology, St. Ignatius College of Education gave a special lecture on "Elements of Effective Teaching" on 20-04-2021. Her presentation was interactive and she made the students differentiate between 'teaching' and 'effective teaching'. She then list the qualities and attitudes required for effective teaching. By providing illustrations, she made the students list the essentials of effective teaching. The lecture was followed by interaction and the students clarified their doubts and gave their feedback on the lecture. The session ended with a vote of thanks by Mrs. A. Vionthini Sylvia, Assistant Professor of Education, Annammal College of Education for Women.
- Mrs. A. Vinothini Sylvia gave a special lecture on "Assessment of Creativity" on 21-04-2021. She began the presentation by defining the term "Creativity". She then explained the steps in the creative process by giving interesting examples. She then elaborated on the assessment of creativity through different tests. She also provided details of standardized tests of creativity. The lecture was followed by interaction and the students clarified their doubts and gave their feedback on the lecture. The session ended with

a vote of thanks proposed by Mrs. J. RawoofuNisha, Assistant Professor of Psychology, St. Ignatius College of Education.

Dr. N. SudhaKumari, Assistant Professor of Education, Annammal College of Education for Women gave a special lecture on "Interplay of Education and Philosophy" on 22-04-2021. She began her presentation by defining 'education' and 'philosophy'. She explained how education and philosophy are related to each other. By comparing the different 'isms' she explained how each of the philosophy impacts the role of education. She ended by posing a question "Which educational philosophy is appealing to you?" The lecture was followed by interaction and the students clarified their doubts and gave their feedback on the lecture. The session ended with a vote of thanks proposed by Dr. R. # REPORT ON SKILL TRAINING PROGRAMME ON 'SPROUTING ENTREPRENEURSHIP IN MARINE PRODUCTS'

#### 21.09.2021 - 23.09.2021

Thirty one members of Entrepreneurship Development Cell of Annammal College of Education for women attended a three day skill training programme on 'SPROUTING ENTREPRENEURSHIP IN MARINE PRODUCTS' at Fisheries College and Research Institute, Thoothukudi, based on the undersigned Memorandum of Understanding of Annammal College of Education for Women and the EDII – Marine Products Business Incubation Forum of Fisheries College and Research Institute, Thoothukudi from 21.09.2021 to 23.09.2021. Dr.P.Ganesan, Assistant Professor and Head, DFPT, FCRI, Thoothukudi welcomed the participants. Mrs.D.Shunmuga Selvasivasankari, Assistant professor of Mathematics and Mrs.R.Thanga Selvam, Assistant professor of Biological science from Annammal College delivered felicitation address on this training. Dr.N.V.Sujath Kumar, the Dean i/c of FCRI delivered the presidential address. The purpose of this training programme was to create entrepreneurs for selling and exporting marine products.

#### Day 1

The first technical session was handled by Dr.P.Ganesan, Assistant Professor and Head, DFPT, FCRI, Thoothukudi on the title 'Avenues of Entrepreneurship in Marine Products'. He elaborated the avenues of Entrepreneurship in Marine Products. He highlighted the government policies on entrepreneurship development in marine products. He discussed on the procedures of receiving funds from government, the facilities available at Marine Products Business Incubation Forum of Fisheries College and Research Institute, Thoothukudi.

Session 2 was handled by Mr.M. Muruganantham, Assistant Professor, DFPT, FCRI, Thoothukudi. He handled the session on the title Traits of Fish Entrepreneurs and Fund Avenues to start Entrepreneurship in Fish Processing'. He explained about the characteristics of fish entrepreneurs. He briefed the fund avenues to start entrepreneurship in fish processing.

On the second day, the students visited the EDII – Incubation forum of FCRI accompanied by Dr.P.Ganesan. He elaborately explained the machineries available at the incubation center for fish entrepreneurs. The students were exposed to the making of bakery products with marine products such as sea weed. Students were given practical training on the preparations of cakes, cookies and buns and breads in the afternoon. Along with the trainers the students made bakery products incorporating with sea weeds. Ms.M.Ruthra, CEO of EDII, FCRI, handled a technical session on the topic The Emerging Techniques in Fish Preservation' and at the end of the day, students were gifted with bakery products in a box.

Day 3

Students were practically involved on the third day. They were trained on preparing Fish pickles, Fish pakoda, Fish cutlets, Sea weed incorporated biscuits and fish burger. The students were also actively involved in the preparation of the above items and were gifted with the products they made.

Dr. N.V.Sujath Kumar, FCRI, Thoothukudi delivered the valedictory address. Ms.Alagu Sundari and Ms.Jebapriya gave feedback about the three days training. The participants were distributed with participation certificates during the valedictory. The programme was ended with the vote of thanks proposed by Dr. P. Ganesan followed by national anthem. The three days training raised awareness on marine entrepreneurship among the students.


