SESSION ON ASSESSMENT OF LEARNING

Annammal College of Education for Women organised a session on 3rd September 2021 titled “Assessment of Learning”. It is arranged at the Shenbagamurthy Hall so as to facilitate the prospective teachers to integrate ICT. The resource person for the session is Dr.K.E.Valarmathi, Learning Officer, Velammal NewGen Edu Networks, Chennai. The resource person tested the previous knowledge of the prospective teachers through Mentimeter app. The participation of the prospective teachers using this app is appreciable as the diagnosis is through gamification.

The core areas focused by the resource person includes testing , evaluation, difference between testing and evaluation, diagnostic test and its purpose, achievement test and its purpose, aptitude and proficiency test, assessment for learning, assessment of learning and assessment as learning. The facilitator covered few more concepts like kinds of written type examinations which includes oral type questions, short answer and essay type questions. She differentiated each of these types with examples. She also covered the steps in planning and construction of an achievement test, characteristics of a good test, analysis of test items using item difficulty and discrimination index through example. A model question paper along with blueprint and mark scheme is shown as an example.

The session was live through the active participation of the prospective teachers. The prospective teachers were given insight on the preparation of online assessment tools using mentimeter app. The prospective teachers were given time to clarify their doubts. They posed questions on difference between assessment for learning and assessment of learning. They were given clarification through examples by the facilitator.

BASIC LITERACY”**

The IQAC of the college organized a special address on “Braille and Assistive Technology: Basic Literacy” on 09-09-2021 at 2 p.m. The address was conducted online through Google Meet and the joining information is: Mr. Vinod Benjamin Rayan, Assistant Manager, Tata Consultancy Services served as the resource person. The students were present in the classroom and got connected through Google Meet for the programme. Dr. R. Suryakala, IQAC Coordinator welcomed the online gathering. Mr. Vinod Benjamin Rayan began his presentation with the history of Braille. She presented visuals on Braille dots and explained how they are helpful to the visually challenged. He then gave a brief explanation of the assistive technologies for writing and reading for the visually challenged. He presented on the different technologies that can make like easy and enjoyable for the visually challenged. He also elaborated on how he learned to use devices to overcome his low vision and to do things like any other non- disabled person. The students raised their queries about assistive technologies and Braille and Mr. Vinod clarified the doubts. The session came to an end with a vote of thanks proposed by Ausmitha Srnithi Christy, first year B. Ed. student.

Dr. Muthukumar began the workshop by differentiating the terms ‘job’ and ‘profession’. He asked the students to make a list of characteristics expected from a professional. DEALING WITH STUDENT DIVERSITY

The IQAC of Annammal College of Education for Women organized a Special Address on “Dealing with Student Diversity” for B. Ed. students on 10-12-2021. Dr. C. Shirley Moral, Assistant Professor, Department of Education, Madurai Kamaraj University, Madurai served as the resource person. The programme was organized in the Shenbagamurthi hall of the college at 11 a.m.

Dr.K. E. Valarmathi, Assistant Professor of Education welcomed and introduced the resource person. Dr. Shirley Moral began her address by defining the term ‘diversity’. She then elaborated on the diversities that exist in the classroom. She mentioned about differences among students based on the following aspects:

- Learning styles
- Socio economic status
- Interests
- Aptitudes
- Intelligence level
- Gender

The students were asked to share about the above mentioned disparities they had noticed in the school days. They were also asked to reflect on how the disparities had affected the performance of students. This was followed by a discussion on the ways of dealing with diversities. Dr.Shirley explained a few techniques to address student diversity in the classroom. She play two videos- one on the “Intention Experiment” by Lynne McTaggart and the other on Flash and Memory Japanese Experiment. The two videos helped the students to understand the power of words and the impact of focused attention. It gives you all the tools which a professional editing software on PC and Mac offers. 4. The Runaway and other stories- Rabindranath Tagore

The book “Ithu yaarudaiya vaguparai?” written by Aysha Natarajan is a book about education and classrooms. A chapter in the book “Our Classrooms, Their Classrooms” deals with the salient features of the education system of different countries. This chapter was taken for reading and discussion. The first book reading session was organized on 08-12-2021.

The book “Great Men and Women” written by Leslie W. Leavitt is a book about the lives of great men and women. A chapter in the book “Madame Curie” tells us the life history of Madam Curie. This chapter was taken for reading and discussion. The second book reading session was organized on 11-12-2021.

The book “Neerpazhi” written by Cho. Tharuman is a collection of short stories. Two short stories; Eeram and Appavikal were taken for reading and discussion. The third book reading session was organized on 15-12-2021.

The book “The Runaway and other stories” written by Rabindranath is a collection of short stories. A story in the book “The Conclusion” is one of the short stories by the author. This story was taken for reading and discussion. The fourth book reading session was organized on 29-12-2021.

The teachers prepared a few questions to be considered for each discussion. The students were seated in a circle on the ground during the discussion. Each question was put forward by the teacher and the students were free to voice their thoughts. The discussion was centered on social issues reflected in the books and helped to gain an understanding of multiple perspectives.

The programme started sharply at 10.15 a.m. with TamilThai Vazhththu. Dr.R.Suryakala, Vice Principal, Annammal College of Education for Women, Thoothukudi presented the welcome address.

Session – I: 10.30 AM – 12.00 PM

The first session is on the topic “Digital Literacy & Effective use of Social Media”. Dr.M.S.Xavier Pradheep Singh, Assistant Professor, PG & Research Department of English St. Joseph’s College (Autonomous), Tiruchirappalli, TamilNadu was the resource person for the session. Dr. K.E.Valarmathi, Assistant Professor of Education, Annammal College of Education for Women, Thoothukudi introduced the resource person. The session started at 10.30 a.m. Dr. Xavier Pradeep started his presentation with a brief overview of his entire presentation. The session was very informative, he gave a detailed information about e-mail, its benefits and generating e-mail id in google. Then he explained about the banking service and its security setting and safety measures. He also gave a good idea on the do’s and don’ts of using the internet and also on the various google apps and banking. He stressed the necessary social precautions to be followed when using the social media along with its benefits and disadvantages. Throughout the session he clearly explained about the email, banking services, google tools and social media. After his presentation, he addressed the queries raised by the students. The session ended by 12.00 p.m.

Session – II: 12.00 PM – 1.30 PM

The second session is on the topic “Personal Capacity Building”. Br. Albert Xaviour, President, GNOSIS - INDIA, IFM was the resource person for the second session. Mrs.A.Vinothini Sylvia, Assistant Professor of Education, Annammal College of

WORKSHOP ON BUILDING LEARNING ENVIRONMENT – TAKE AWAY FROM US EDUCATION SYSTEM

School environment is characterized by its facilities, classroom practices, school-based supports and disciplinary policies and procedures. Learning environment must provide inclusive education providing needed accommodations to meet specific needs of students with disabilities. Teachers play a vital role in having positive attitude, active engagement and receptiveness in providing effective learning environment. Teachers must be aware that they cannot diagnose, but provide feedback to parents, other therapists so the students with disabilities could receive needs help with physicians and psychologists. Learning environment could be learner centered, knowledge centered, assessment centered or community centered, of which student centered learning brings optimal learning environment. Creative inclusive learning environment has the following steps 1. Start with Individual educational plan 2. Room arrangement 3. Flexible seating 4. Schedule based student need 5. Appropriate materials (differentiated instruction) 6. Collaboration between all stakeholders 7. Co-teaching 8. Feedback (re-evaluate) Elements for positive learning environment are safety, engagement, connectiveness and support. Learning environment must include learning resources such as technology, means of teaching, models of learning, and connections to global and societal contexts. Consider having SMART goals as a teacher and for students. S- specific M-measurable A-attainable R-relevant T-time-based The participants discussed how to provide best possible learning environment to a specific passage (grade 3 text-English) about Sachin Tendulkar. The student teachers were asked to discuss in groups and come up with how they would provide suitable learning environment to all students and deliver instruction. The team leaders came up with variety of strategies. The session was wrapped up with modelling strategies for the lesson. Attendees were asked to complete a feedback google form.

PRE- PRACTICE TEACHING ADDITIONAL INPUTS FOR STUDENT TEACHERS

Participants: B.Ed. II year students

Pre- Practice Teaching Additional Inputs for Student Teachers was organized by Annammal College of Education for women, on 28.07.2022. It was conducted by four sessions and four topics were covered.

Session 1 - Topic: Content Mapping

Resource Person: Mrs.N.Prabha, Assistant Professor of Education, Annammal College of Education for Women, Thoothukudi

The resource person explained about what content mapping is and how to use it in their intensive teaching practice. Content maps have a variety of uses in supporting the professional development of teachers, including serving as a tool that allows teachers to define the content to be taught in an instructional unit, a teaching tool that can be used to teach content knowledge, and an assessment tool to assess the content knowledge of pre-service and in-service teachers. It helps students to organize new information. It helps students to make meaningful connections between the main idea and other information. They're easy to construct and can be used within any content area. Developing content knowledge in teachers presents a constant challenge for educators.

Session 2 - Topic: Identifying Varied Students Abilities

Resource Person: Mrs. T.Emima Rolanshia, Assistant Professor of Education, Annammal College of Education for Women, Thoothukudi

The resource person explained how to identify students with different learning abilities. Some students may be able to read exceptionally well, while others may not be able to read at all. Conducting assessments can help teachers identify a student's individual academic skills, learning styles and interests in mixed-ability classrooms. She shared her thoughts about teaching students with various learning abilities, which involves creativity, time and a desire to understand how a student learns best. Session 3 - Topic: Inclusive Classroom Practice

Resource Person: Mrs.A.Jeyakavitha, Assistant Professor of Computer Science, Annammal College of Education for Women, Thoothukudi

Inclusive education is based on the principle of participation. Inclusive education involves all children in common educational settings where they can learn together without any discrimination. It provides opportunities for students with disabilities for active participation equally. She shared her views on the role of the teacher in an inclusive classroom. Inclusive education happens when children with and without disabilities participate and learn together in the same classes. She explained that when a child with disabilities attends classes alongside peers who do not have disabilities, good things happen. Inclusion is about providing the help children need to learn and participate in meaningful ways.

Session 4 - Topic: Visualizing Differential learning Abilities

Resource Person: Mrs. T.Emima Rolanshia, Assistant Professor of Education, Annammal College of Education for Women, Thoothukudi

Learning disabilities are due to genetic and/or neurobiological factors that alter brain functioning in a manner which affects one or more cognitive processes related to learning. These processing problems can interfere with learning basic skills such as reading, writing and/or math. They can also interfere with higher level skills such as organization, time planning, abstract reasoning, long or short-term memory and attention. She explained about the types and causes of disabilities. They are visual impairment, Physical disabilities, Dyslexia / Dyscalculia / Dyspraxia, Mental health difficulties, hearing impairment. She explained about visual related cues and information and different assessment methods for visual impaired students. She taught students how to handle physical disabilities. She gave the definition of Dyslexia / Dyscalculia / Dyspraxia and also explained about what the teaching methods were given. We can provide written forms of learning materials for hearing-impaired students.
